Agenda Items and Comments:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.

Erica Galloway called the meeting to order at 6:07 p.m.

A review was held of the Certificate of Appropriateness application for Luke Allison of TazeMoto, LLC for 320 Main Street. Luke participated in the discussion via Zoom. He explained that he has received approval from Virginia's Department of Historic Resources for his project with caveats that included exposed brick requirements and some drywall changes. The project will take 12-14 months once started. He anticipates the commercial space will be open sooner, possibly 2023. HRB voted unanimously, minus Susan Reeves who recused herself from voting due to a conflict of interest, to approve this COA application contingent on Luke sending a copy of the amended changes that were approved by DHR.

A review was held of the COA application for Mason Dixon Brothers, LLC. for 113 Fincastle Turnpike. Drawings of the intended changes were submitted for review with the application. HRB voted unanimously to approve the door and window modifications outlined in the drawings. There were additional questions that Susan will send to Town of Tazewell Zoning Administrator Chris Hurley regarding any changes they might make to the stoop and garage. Additionally, Planning Commission may need to review their signage to ensure that it meets the current zoning requirements.

Nominees were discussed for the HRB vacancy. A candidate and backup candidate were nominated and HRB voted unanimously to approve them. Terry Mullins will contact the first candidate and let HRB know of his interest. If none, the second candidate will be contacted. Due to recent changes of the HRB members, a new Chairperson was needed. Erica was nominated as Chairperson and with Erica moving from Vice-Chairperson to Chairperson, a Vice-Chairperson was now needed. Joe was nominated as Vice-Chairperson and both changes were unanimously approved.

Susan Reeves discussed the current list of webinars available from Preservation Virginia's "Preservation Academy" series, which are held in conjunction with Virginia's Department of Historic Resources. The webinars cover many topics important to historic review boards and preservationists. Susan attended their webinar regarding Historic Marker Programs recently. Due to the 18-month backlog at DHR for review of historic marker applications, DHR is now actively encouraging municipalities, HRB's, and Historical Society's to develop their own historic marker program. The webinar covered this process at a high level and included guest speakers who are working toward this goal. Susan will gather more information on this program development to share with HRB.
